

# **2025 Scholarship Program**

## REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicant must be a member in good standing of Autotruck Financial Credit Union to be eligible to apply.

2. The maximum scholarship for each student selected for the school year will be \$2,000. Only those individuals who are registered or will be registering as a full-time student at an Accredited College, University or Trade School need apply. Scholarship money will be paid directly to the Accredited College, University or Trade School.

### Submit the following information by April 1, 2025:

- 1. Completed Application.
- 2. Official Transcript with a cumulative GPA of 2.75 including SAT/ACT test results. If attending a Trade School and no SAT/ACT applicable, include official transcript from latest school attended. (Must be initiated by a Counselor or Registrar's Office.)
- 3. A signed Letter of Recommendation from a high school teacher, counselor, college professor or administrator, community or church leader or any non family member.
- 4. A copy of the Acceptance Letter from the Accredited College, University or Trade School.
- 5. List of Academic Achievements.
- 6. List of all Extracurricular Activities such as school activities.
- 7. List of Community Involvement such as organizations, church and volunteer work. Provide the name of the organization, the type of work and the time involved.
- 8. Essay of 500-550 typed words\* answering the following question:

Tell us about your career goals. What type of job are you wanting and how will your talents and skills best be utilized in that profession? What impact will that job have on you and your family? What is your biggest motivation for success?

9. List Tuition Cost and provide name and amount of any Financial Assistance you will be receiving.

- Completed Application (Maximum of 5 Points)
- Official Transcript (including SAT/ACT if applicable) (must be initialed by a Counselor or the Registrar's Office) (Maximum of 5 Points)
- Signed Letter of Recommendation (Maximum of 5 Points)
- Letter of Acceptance from the Accredited College, University or Trade School (Maximum of 5 Points)
- List of Academic Achievements (Maximum of 10 Points)
- List of all Extracurricular Activities (Maximum of 10 Points)
- List of Community Involvement (Maximum of 10 Points)
- Typed Essay with between 500-550 words (Maximum of 45 Points)
- List tuition cost and provide the name and dollar amount of any financial assistance (Maximum of 5 Points)

### Entries must be postmarked no later than April 1, 2025.
